MEMBERSHIP/CERTIFICATION

MEMBERSHIP/CERTIFICATION

Each Crime Stopper Programme is required to keep on file evidence of "Membership/Certification" with the following organizations:

- A) Crime Stoppers International
- B) Canadian Association of Crime Stoppers
- C) Ontario Association of Crime Stoppers

MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING

In order that an Ontario Crime Stoppers Programme may be deemed to be a "Member in Good Standing" the following provisions must be met:

1. Crime Stoppers International - Article X - Membership Section 3 - Classification of Membership - The Membership of C.S.I. shall consist of:
 - A) **VOTING MEMBERS** - "Member programmes - Any Crime Stoppers Programme worldwide, established as a private, non profit organization in accordance with the prevailing laws of the State/Province and Country in which the programme is located, whose DUES are paid. (See the Policies and Procedures Manual) (Also See Guideline C - C.S.I. Bylaws)
 - B) **CANADIAN ASSOCIATION OF CRIME STOPPERS - By Laws**

(See Guideline D)
 - C) **ONTARIO ASSOCIATION OF CRIME STOPPERS - Bylaw No. 1 - "INTERPRETATION" - Section 1.9 "In Good Standing" - means any member that has PAID HIS/HER ANNUAL DUES to the Corporation (O.A.C.S.) and Crime Stoppers International. (See Guideline E)**

In addition, member programmes must be in general compliance with the bylaws, policies and procedures of Crime Stoppers International, the Canadian Association of Crime Stoppers and the Ontario Association of Crime Stoppers.
